

We are delighted that you are considering Aurora Hyde Lodge for the next stage in your journey, and we look forward to welcoming you into our wider family.




About Hyde Lodge

Situated close to Bristol city centre, Aurora Hyde Lodge provides a warm and welcoming environment in the heart of a vibrant and bustling community, offering young adults with complex needs the opportunity to participate in and enjoy everyday life.

As a CQC-registered care home, we provide 52-week residential placements for young adults aged 19+ who require structured and supported living and care.

Our lower floor is accessible by wheelchair and designed for ease of use by those with reduced mobility, while our eight modern, comfortable bedrooms can be adapted to meet any health or mobility needs.

Food is prepared in the two kitchens in the house and everyone participates in choosing and making their own meals. Residents enjoy access to two large, open-plan living and dining areas with beautiful views across Westbury Park, as well as our own private gardens and outdoor spaces.





Your experience with us

Being part of the community, having a healthy social network and taking part in physical activities are all part of the way of life at Aurora Hyde Lodge. We encourage independence while also offering high levels of support, enabling every person we work with to develop their own unique skills, interests and abilities.

Each of our residents enjoys a personal timetable of activities, collaboratively designed and delivered with the support of an in-house tutor. Activities are planned to reflect each resident's interests, develop their independent living skills and promote work-related learning. The skills developed through these activities are integrated into residents' daily routines, helping to build their confidence and promote a sense of achievement.



As well as a variety of social and recreational activities, there are plenty of opportunities to take part in our work experience and Enterprise programmes, while residents with a valid Education, Health and Care Plan can also access courses at our local college in Bristol.


